being a person of good repute, hath duly presented to me a Memorial praying that Letters of Naturalization may be granted to him, and a Certificate as by law is required, and hath since duly taken the oath prescribed by the Aliens Act, 1908:

Now know ye that I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the said Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power vested in me by the said Act, do hereby grant unto the said

these Letters of Naturalization, and that he, the said

Holger Christian Jarlov
shall hereafter have and enjoy all the rights and capacities which a natural-born subject of the United Kingdom can enjoy or transmit within the Dominion of New Zealand.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Right Honourable Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George; Member of the Royal Victorian Order; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over His Majesty's Dominion of New Zealand and its Dependencies; and issued under the Seal of the said Dominion, at the Government House at Wellington, in the Dominion aforesaid, this ninth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirteen,
