IN THE ESTATE of CHARLES LARSEN late of
Umutaoroa near Dannevirke,
Farmer deceased.

WE, NEIL LAURITZ LARSEN of Waipawa in Hawkes Bay, Farmer
and ALBERT JOHN LARSEN of Taumatatahi in Taranaki, Farmer
do hereby severally make oath and say as follows:-

1. THAT we knew the said Charles Larsen of
Umutaoroa near Dannevirke aforesaid now deceased when
alive and that the said deceased was resident or was
domiciled at Umutaoroa aforesaid within this Judicial
District and that the nearest Registry Office of this
Court to the place where the said Charles Larsen resided
or was domiciled is at Palmerston North.

2. THAT the said Charles Larsen died at
Taumatatahi aforesaid on the fifth day of July One thou-
sand nine hundred and thirty three, as we are able to
depose from having been present at his funeral.

3. THAT we believe the typewritten document
now produced and marked "A" bearing date the third day
of November One thousand nine hundred and thirty two
to be the last Will and Testament of the said deceased
and that we are the Executors therein named.

4. THAT we will faithfully execute the said
Will by paying the debts and legacies of the said
deceased so far as the property will extend and the law
binds.

5. THAT according to our knowledge and belief

the estate and effects of the said deceased in respect of which Probate is sought to be obtained are under the value of £1000.

THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me CHARLES LARSEN of Umutaoroa in the Provincial District of Hawkes Bay and Dominion of New Zealand, Farmer I REVOKE all former Wills and Testamentary writings at any time heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last Will.

1. I APPOINT NEIL LAURITZ LARSEN of Waipawa, Farmer and ALBERT JOHN LARSEN of Taumatatahi, Farmer (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Trustees and Executors of this my Will.

2. I DECLARE that in the interpretation of this my Will the expression "my Trustees" shall where the context permits mean and include the Trustee or Trustees for the time being hereof whether original or substituted.

3. I DIRECT my Trustees to allow my son Oliver Charles Larsen who has been farming in partnership with me to have the use and occupation of my farm lands at Umutaoroa and all stock and implements belonging to me or in which I have a half share, for a period of FIVE YEARS from the date of my death on condition that he shall pay all current outgoings, interest on mortgages charges and expenses in connection with such land and farming business during this period.

4. ON the expiry of Five years from the date of my death:-

(a) I give and bequeath to my son the said Oliver Charles Larsen one half of all live stock belonging to me (after an equal division has been made in accordance with the then value thereof) and my half share in the Motor Car and Lorry and all implements plant and farm tools belonging to me or in which I have one half interest as aforesaid.

(b) I give the rest of my property both real and personal (hereinafter called "my residuary estate") to my Trustees upon trust to sell call in and otherwise convert into money the same with power to postpone for so long as they shall think fit the sale and conversion of any part whatever of my said estate and in the meantime and pending such sale and conversion to lease any part or parts of my residuary estate and generally manage the same in their discretion and to hold the net proceeds of such sale and conversion UPON TRUST

(a) To pay my funeral graveyard and testamentary expenses and debts.

(b) To divide the capital and accrued interest between all my children then living in equal shares as tenants in common.

This is the typewritten document produced and marked "A" and shown to Neil Lauritz Larsen and Albert John Larsen and referred to in their affidavits sworn at Dannevirke this 1933, before me:-

5. IT IS my wish that any death duties payable on my estate shall be borne and paid by my children in proportion to the value of the share in my estate which he or she shall take respectively

6. IN the event of any of my children paying or advancing money for the payment of my said debts funeral and testamentary expenses and death duties I direct that the same shall be refunded to him, her or them out of my residuary estate before distribution thereof.

7. I DIRECT that should any child of mine die in my lifetime or before the period of distribution leaving issue living at that period of time such issue shall stand in the place of such deceased child and shall take (equally among them if more than one) the share in my estate which such deceased child would have taken had he or she survived me and attained a vested interest.

8. I DECLARE that my Trustees shall have power to raise on Mortgage of any hereditaments for the time being vested in them any principal money which may be required for any of the purposes of my Will and to secure the repayment of any money so raised as aforesaid with interest at such rate as may be thought proper by Mortgage in fee simple and for any term of years of the hereditaments to be charged therewith.

9. I DECLARE that the Statutory Power of Appointment of new Trustees shall be exercisable by my Trustees or the survivor of them.

IN WITNESS whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand this 3rd day of November One thousand nine hundred and thirty two.
