FOREWORD

The sources of my information in the following pages are many and varied. Back numbers of early Wairarapa papers have confirmed much of the factual early history of the old pioneers as related to me by the older members of the lineage, and where possible steps have been taken to check and cross check the accuracy of stories that may, over the years, have become a little vague in the memories of the narrators. Despite the occasional lapse, I have been astounded with the tremendously retentive memories of most of the older people, and it was from them that most of the early personal history was derived. In my search for information I visited twenty cemeteries, visited early settlers' organisations, registrars of births, deaths and marriages, perused early newspapers, and even went so far as to write to Oslo. The most vital link, however, in the chain leading to our earliest recorded ancestor, was found in an old Norwegian bible, originally owned by Hans Larsen, and now in the possession of Charles Larsen, his son, at Ohura. The wording, translated by Charles, is as follows:—

"This book belongs to Hans Larsen, Mauriceville, born 4th August, 1839, in Odalen by parents Lars Hansen and Eli Jorkelsen. Karen Hansen (his wife), born May 30th, 1840 by parents Hans Amundsen and Kerni Olsen, at Opsten Braaten, Odalen. A passage was decided 1855. Married May 25th, 1863".

A prayer book originally belonging to his mother, but now in the possession of Halvord's daughter Ellen, gives Eli's name as Jorkelsdatter meaning daughter of Jorkel, but her family name became Jorkelsen at a later period. The entry in the prayer book is as follows:—

"Den bog tilhøra mig, Eli Jorkelsdatter. Fordt 15dc Feb 1816". Translated: This book belongs to me, Eli Jorkelsdatter, born 15th Feb., 1816.

I have been unable to trace the existence of early family group photos of Karen Isakson and Hans Larsen, but have managed to locate the remainder. The greatly increased birth rate of later generations has also precluded the recording of descendants since mid 1954. I regret that I had to draw the line there, but the situation was getting out of hand.

Only blood descendants have been recorded on the family tree, and at the express wish of a few members, I have omitted to include one or two names.

My thanks are due to all relations who co-operated so willingly by supplying photos, paper clippings, and early records, and especially to Arthur Larsen in Brisbane who relieved me of so much work by handling so ably the details of the branch in Australia. To my mother, Ellen Dawson, whose good memory was such a help in the early stages, and to my wife, Jess, who has travelled many hundreds of miles with me as my chief statistician and unpaid secretary, a thousand thanks. Although not a Larsen, she has been just as keen and intensely interested as I.

In conclusion, I trust that this history and the accompanying Family Tree, will satisfy the desire for knowledge that I found so evident in the course of my enquiries, and that pride and pleasure will be felt by all who peruse it down through the ages.

NESTLING in a little valley on the south shore of LAKE ODALEN in the county of SOLOR and about forty miles north of OSLO lies the little town of OPSTAD or OPSTEN BRAATEN as it was then known. There, in the year 1813 just two years before Napoleon was defeated at Waterloo, a child was born to HANS, a resident of that town and he was given the name LARS. According to the custom of that time he was called LARS HANSEN, which really means LARS, the son of HANS. His family, like most other Norwegian families living in the snow-bound hinterland at that time, were in impoverished circumstances, living frugally, raising large families, working hard and leading a God-fearing existence among the small circle of villagers in their immediate vicinity.

In due course, LARS grew up and at the age of 24 he married ELI JORKELSEN, who had earlier been known as ELI JORKELSDATTER (ELI the daughter of JORKEL). Thereafter she and the subsequent family adopted the family name of LARSEN and contrary to Norwegian custom, retained this name to be perpetuated by future generations 15,000 miles distant. The marriage took place in the year 1837, the year that VICTORIA the girl Queen ascended the throne of England. And so, from these two young people in an obscure village in Norway commenced a lineage that was destined to reach the amazing total of almost eight hundred direct descendants by the year 1954.

ELI, which is probably an abbreviation of Elizabeth, was 21 years of age at this time, having been born February 15th in the year 1816, and the couple settled down in OPSTEN BRAATEN and raised a family of six children, HANS, who was born in 1838, KAREN 1843, LARS 1853, ELIZABETH 1857, HALVORD 1860, and KARL 1861.

Life in NORWAY for the inland inhabitants, was at that time fraught with privations and hardships, with little promise of an assured future for a growing family. The governments of Norway, Sweden and Denmark were alive to this situation and encouragement was being given to families to seek their fortunes in the newly colonised lands of New Zealand and Australia. The glowing pictures of the rosy future and the new life to be found in New Zealand convinced the couple that their future lay in the Antipodes

and accordingly a passage to New Zealand was decided upon as early as 1855, but not until 1873 did they arrive. By this time however, LARS senior had died and the two eldest children, HANS and KAREN, had married. In 1863 HANS had married KAREN HANSEN, who was born May 30th, 1840, and whose parents were HANS AMUNDSEN and KERNI OLSEN of OPSTEN BRAATEN. There were four children of their marriage when the passage was made, but one died during the voyage and was buried at sea. The remaining three children were LIZZIE aged 10 years, HANS 4, and CARRIE who was born during the voyage or very shortly after. HANS' sister KAREN had married OLE ISAKSON and had two children, OLE aged 4 years, and MARY, a babe in arms. Then, of course, to complete the party, there were the other brothers and sisters. The party embarked from KRISTIANA for LONDON and here, early in 1873, after a long stay, they set sail together with three hundred other Scandinavians, on a boat sailing for New Zealand. It was a nightmare voyage, marked by sea-sickness and discomfort, lack of good food, medical attention and hygiene. One would not need to stretch the imagination very far to visualise the relief felt by all on their arrival at Napier after months of a life to which they were completely unaccustomed. Their journey was not by any means at an end, however, as the long and arduous trek to KOPURANGA still lay before them. The country over which they had to traverse, was through standing bush, over unbridged rivers and swamps and across trackless mountains. With the two KARENS carrying their babies, mother ELI, now 57, assisting with the provisions, and the men carrying the younger members of the family as well as provisions and their personal possessions, the party started off from Napier for their new homes in the Wairarapa. Their first staging camp was at the newly settled village of Norsewood where a monument has since been erected to mark the exact site of the early pioneers. There they rested for some days, building up their strength for the greater task that lay before them. On and on they plodded, making a few hard won miles each day, camping when night fell, and pushing on at first light, through some of the heaviest wooded country in New Zealand. At last they arrived at "THE CAMP" at

KOPURANGA, on the edge of the FORTY MILE BUSH, where they were amongst friends, and here, after a journey that would be unthinkable by to-day's standards, the party set about absorbing themselves into their new way of life. To those who were old enough, an area of forty acres was leased by the Government at a nominal rental, and from this, each lessee was expected to carve out a home and existence for his family. HANS, the eldest son, took upon himself the responsibility of caring for his mother now nearly sixty years of age, as well as the younger members of the family, and very soon, by working as roadmen, labouring for the more affluent neighbours, as well as clearing their own sections, they had established themselves as part of the community. By this time they had built themselves small slab whares, with calico windows, and wooden chimneys daubed with clay. Several times these were burned to the ground in the bush fires but life went on as before. The usual social groups had sprung up in the district and ELI and her children were soon prominent in their activities. Continuing the habits of their homeland, the family, who had always been strictly brought up in the Lutheran faith, became keen church workers, and seven days a week the family bible was brought out and a chapter or two read by the senior member present. Church on Sunday was attended by all members, and this practice was observed strictly for several generations. They soon learned the English language, especially the younger ones, although in their homes their native tongue was mostly spoken. English habits and customs came quickly, but many of the customs of life, food and dress of their homeland prevailed for many years. For example, it was not uncommon for the older members of the family, both male and female, to produce their clay pipes and twist tobacco, while they talked over the events of the day. This habit died out amongst the female section with the passing of the first generation.

As time went by, the families grew and prospered. HANS raised a family of eight of which only one member is now living, CHARLES, aged 78, at OHURA. By hard work, self denial and perseverance, he managed to provide, not only for his own growing family, but also his younger brothers and sister, HALVORD, KARL and ELIZABETH, until

they were able to fend for themselves. As well as the manual work the younger ones were expected to do, all received a good schooling and one son, DICK, chose school teaching as his career, eventually settling in TARANAKI. LIZZIE married and moved to Dannevirke, setting an all time record by having 118 direct descendants since her marriage in 1887. LAURITZ and ALF did not marry and both died in Taranaki, being buried in New Plymouth cemetery. HANS junior, who was sometimes known as HARRY, moved to Taranaki, purchased a farm, and raised a family of eight. Most of this branch of the family are still in this district, and it is interesting to note, even five generations departed, such typical Norwegian names as HARALD and ERIK. Both CARRIE and JENNY married and remained in the Wairarapa district. HANS senior, despite the privations of his early life, reached the ripe old age of seventy-nine years, when he died in Mauriceville, and no citizen of the district was more respected than this sturdy pioneer who has produced 256 direct descendants to date. He was buried in 1918, in a little churchyard on a hill at Mauriceville North, a few paces from the quaint little church that played such a large part in his life. This building which had for so long witnessed the baptisms, weddings and funerals of so many he held dear, now cast its shadow on his last resting place. But he was not alone. Nearby are the graves of his brother LARS, sister KAREN, and his mother ELI, who had passed away at the grand old age of eighty years. On his mother's headstone the following epitaph is to be found:

"Weep not for me my children dear

"I am not dead but sleeping here".

By some strange chance the same inscription is on the grave of her son KARL who died in 1933, and was buried in the Dannevirke cemetery, and also on the grave of her son, HALVORD in Australia. This was purely accidental and was a happy coincidence. It is pleasing to know that these graves are in a good state of preservation.

Both KAREN and LARS who remained in their adopted district reached more than their allotted span, KAREN passing away at the age of ninety years, and LARS reaching the age of seventy-four at his death. The former raised a family of nine of which LAURA, ELLEN and CHARLES are the sur-

viving members, while JACOB, JACK, OLE, LAURITZ, MARY and ANNIE have since passed on. The history of this branch of the family, like the others, is one of privations and fortitude, and eventual triumph over adversity. The children of both KAREN and LARS, unlike those of HANS, KARL and HALVORD, did not migrate far from the parental doorstep, and excepting for the last generation or two, most of the descendants are still to be found within 100 miles of the original home.

LARS raised a family of eleven, the surviving members being BETTY, EMMA, ALEX, ANNIE, CHARLIE, OWEN, NORMAN and MAY. Those who have passed on, are CONNIE, KATE and MAUD. Reading through early editions, one finds that LARS was an outstanding athlete and marksman in his younger days, competing with much success in the athletic meetings and shooting tournaments of the day. His name, together with that of HALVORD and KARL, was prominent in social activities of the district.

ELIZABETH, who was sixteen when she arrived in New Zealand, married HERMAN FREDRICKSON just a year later in 1874. He had arrived in New Zealand from Sweden in the ship HEVDIG the same year as ELIZABETH, and speaking practically the same language, they found much in common. She raised a family of eight of which the surviving members are LAURA, AGNES and VIC. Those who have passed on are ANNIE, HILMA, ALFRED, HARRY and EMMA. Some of ELIZABETH'S family moved to different parts of the country. LAURA to Otaki, AGNES to Taranaki and HARRY to Dannevirke. ELIZABETH still found time, despite her family duties, to play a prominent part in the social activities of the district, being an active Red Cross worker and an enthusiastic member of the Presbyterian church. She was always on hand to assist those in trouble, through sickness or sorrow, and her demise at the comparatively early age of sixty-seven was an occasion for mourning in the district. A few years before her death, she paid a visit to Queensland accompanied by her daughter LAURA, and there they visited her brother HALVORD. It was shortly after this that she died in 1924, and was buried at Eketahuna.

As soon as KARL, or CHARLIE as he was known, became old enough, he also availed himself of the government's offer

of forty acres, and he too settled in Forty Mile Bush locality marrying HANNAH NEILSEN who bore him twelve children. Of these nine are surviving, ALBERT, ELLEN, NEIL, OLLIVER, EVA, SYD, EMMA, FRED and ERNIE; those deceased being EDWARD, CLARA and MINNIE, all of whom died at an early age. KARL did not stay in the Wairarapa any great length of time after his marriage but migrated to UMUTAOROA, a short distance from Dannevirke which was then a Danish settlement. There he raised his family and hewed himself a farm out of undeveloped country. Although not a robust man he was a stern task master to his sons, accepting nothing less than one hundred per cent efficiency. This characteristic which was general in all the family of LARS and ELI paid good dividends and the basic training of his sons was reflected in later years by their success as farmers. Only one child, SYD, remained in the locality the rest having moved to such places as Waverley, Hastings, Napier, Morrinsville, Rotorua, Palmerston North and Te Kuiti. His descendants are now scattered all over the North Island, and number over one hundred. KARL as a young man, visited Australia with a view to settling there, but returned to New Zealand after a short stay. He was a staunch member of the Methodist Church, and took an active interest in local affairs especially dairy farming interests. He was recognised as an authority on up-to-date farming methods and was always first in the field with new ideas; being the first in the district to utilise milking machines, and also water power to drive them. He passed away shortly after his wife in 1933, and was buried with her in the Dannevirke cemetery.

HALVORD at an early age decided to emigrate to Australia and his first job in that country was in a stone quarry on the railway line between MUDGEE and WALLERWERANG in New South Wales. Subsequent to that he went to Queensland and worked on a farm at SWANFELS. He then purchased some land at FREESTONE nearby, on the Darling Downs, and by his own labours he managed to clear it and also the adjoining land which he later purchased. He had two hundred and forty acres at the Homestead and an additional four hundred acres at GLENGALLEN some six miles away. He married and raised a family of eight children of which NELLIE, NORMAN, IVY, CHARLIE and ARTHUR

are still living, while TED, HILMA and MARIE have passed on. His again was a story of triumph over adversity. He did not have the guiding hand of his parents or brothers, nor did he have the little encouragement which had been accorded to his brothers by government settlement schemes. Only by his dogged determination did he succeed. Accompanied by his daughter HILMA he revisited New Zealand and renewed his family ties before returning to WARWICK where he died in 1938.

To the reader who remembers the older members of the family several memories must remain predominant in his mind. Firstly, the parental devotion and hospitality accorded not only to their own families, but to all relations and friends. Every home was open at all times to members of another branch of the family—the coffee pot was always on the stove ready for the unexpected visitor, and the larder was always full no matter what the size of the family or the degree of poverty. Indeed, it was the accepted custom, and the family links were always closely knit. Secondly, the spirit of co-operation which existed between those early pioneer families. They shared misfortunes equally as they shared their labour, implements and ideas, without thought of reward or payment. It would be difficult for us to appreciate in our present dispassionate way of life the heartbreaks, disappointments, privations and sacrifice made by these pioneers but we can, after surveying the results of their efforts, realise the satisfaction and sense of achievement that they must have felt when, in the twilight of their years, they could look around them and see what had been created from nothing by their own efforts. Theirs was an example of courage, tenacity and determination that we all hope will manifest itself in the characters of the generations yet to come.

This then, is our heritage. No royal blood runs in our veins nor coat of arms adorn our halls, but no man can look with a greater sense of pride upon his ancestry than we, the descendants of a people who, by their example, have carved themselves a permanent place in the history of New Zealand, and who, by their achievements, will always be remembered in places where the colonising of New Zealand is discussed.
