Matrimony John Egg . . . and Mildred Garratt
both of the County aforesaid.

NOW the Condition of
the above Obligation is such that if the above bound
John Egg and David Patterson shall well and
truly keep harmless, all and every person, or persons
whatsoever concerned in Issuing, and executing the said
licencie, then the above Obligation to be void, Or else
to remain in full force and Virtue.
