Sealed with our seals, and dated this *10th* day of *December* 1835

The condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas there is a MARRIAGE intended to be solemnized between the above named *Thomas Ogg* and *Martha Fulcher* Now if there be no lawful cause to obstruct the same, then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.
