IN THE ESTATE OF EUPHEMIA McILVRIDE

1. PETER McILVRIDE of Dannevirke in the Dominion of New Zealand,  
Retired, make oath and say as follows:-

1. THAT I know EUPHEMIA McILVRIDE now deceased when alive and  
that the said EUPHEMIA McILVRIDE was resident or was domiciled at  
Dannevirke within this Judicial District and that the nearest Registry  
Office of this Court to the place where the said EUPHEMIA McILVRIDE  
resided or was domiciled is at Palmerston North.

2. THAT the said EUPHEMIA McILVRIDE died at Dannevirke on or  
about the third day of January, 1946 as I am able to depose from  
having seen her dead body after death.

3. THAT I believe the typewritten document now produced and  
shown to me bearing date the 9th day of December, 1942 to be the last  
will and testament of the said deceased and that I am the executor  
therein according to the tenor thereof.

4. THAT I will faithfully execute the said will by paying the  
debts and legacies of the said deceased so far as the property will  
extend and the law binds and will whenever ordered so to do after  
the grant of probate to me file in this Court and verify by affidavit  
a true full and perfect inventory of all the estate effects and credits  
of the said deceased which shall have come into my hands possession or  
knowledge and also a full distinct and proper account of my execution  
of the will which shall set forth the dates and particulars of the  
receipts and disbursements and show which of the same are in my opinion  
on account of capital and on account of income respectively.

5. THAT according to my knowledge and belief the estate and  
effects of the said deceased in respect of which probate is sought to  
be obtained are under the value of £2300 P.M.J. *1/4/46*

6. THAT I was born on a British ship enroute from England to  
New Zealand and am a British subject by birth and that I am not and  
never have been an alien enemy within the meaning of the Enemy Property  
Emergency Regulations 1939.

7. THAT I was informed by my said wife and verily believe that  
the said EUPHEMIA McILVRIDE deceased was born at Wanganui in New  
Zealand and was never an alien enemy within the meaning of the said  
regulations.

8. THAT according to my knowledge information and belief based  
upon the result of my inquiries and particularly upon the information  
referred to in the last preceding paragraph hereof the said deceased  
was not at the time of her death an alien enemy within the meaning of  
the said regulations.

I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all the estate both real and personal of which I shall be possessed to which I shall be entitled or over which I shall have any disposing power at my death to my husband PETER McILVRIDE absolutely and I APPOINT my said husband sole executor of this my last will.
