Christie the Last Will and Testament  
of me Isabella Grace Nation of Levin in New Zealand  
Wife of Charles Cecil Nation of Chakine Trust  
I revoke all Will and Testamentary dispositions  
at any time heretofore made by me And declare  
this only to be my last Will and Testament  
I appoint The Public Trustee for the Dominion of  
New Zealand Trustee and Executor of this my Will  
I give devise and bequeath all my real and personal  
estate of whatever nature and kind unto my said  
Trustee upon trust for all my children during at  
my decease in equal shares and if there shall  
be only one child then in trust for such one  
child absolutely And if I shall die without  
having a child or children so surviving -  
Then I give devise and bequeath my said  
real and personal estate to my Trustee upon  
trust for my brother and sisters in equal  
shares and proportions And I declare that if  
my brother or any of my sisters shall die in  
my lifetime having issue who shall survive  
me and who shall attain the age of Twenty-one  
years such issue shall take but if more than  
one equally between them the share which their  
he or her parent would have taken of and  
in my estate if such parent had lived to  
attain a vested interest I authorize and  
empower my Trustee during the minority  
of any children or child of mine to expend  
such part or parts of the proceeds of my  
said estate as he shall think fit in  
educating maintaining and bringing up  
any such child or children

In witness whereof I have to this my  
last Will and Testament set my hand

this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November One  
thousand nine hundred and twelve

Signed and acknowledged by the  
testatrix, the said Isabella Grace  
Nation as and for her last  
Will and Testament in the  
presence of us both being present  
at the said time who at her  
request in her presence and sight  
and in the presence and sight of  
each other have hereunto signed  
our names as witnesses
