I, RICHARD THOMAS PEACOCK of the City of Wellington
Solicitor make oath and say as follows :-

1. THAT Lance Edward Olaf Tunnington of The Wilderness,
Gordon Road, Camberley, Surrey, England, Airline Pilot
was killed in an aircraft accident at Star Hill,
Hartfordbridge, Hartley, Wintney, Hampshire, England on
the 1st day of May 1957.

2. THAT the said Lance Edward Olaf Tunnington was at
the day of his death employed as an Airline Pilot by
Eagle Aviation Limited.

3. THAT the said deceased died intestate a bachelor
leaving John Edward Tunnington his lawful father the
only person entitled to his estate.

4. THAT pursuant to a Power of Attorney made in that
behalf by the said John Edward Tunnington appointing
Cynan Evan Davies of London, Solicitor, his attorney Letters
of Administration in England in the estate of the said
deceased were granted to the said Cynan Evan Davies.

5. THAT apart from funeral expenses the only debt
owing by the deceased at the date of his death was the
sum of £14. 0. Od. due to one First Officer John Leach.

6. THAT the said John Edward Tunnington gave me his
cheque on an English Bank for the said sum of £14. 0. Od.

which I sent to Messrs. Ashton Hill & Co., Solicitors, Nottingham, England, the solicitors for Eagle Aviation Limited to remit to the said First Officer John Lesch in a covering letter dated 6th June 1957.

7. THAT on or about the 24th June 1957 I received a letter dated the 14th June 1957 from the said Messrs. Ashton Hill & Co. stating that they had sent the said cheque for £14. 0. 0d. to the said First Officer John Lesch.

8. THAT arising out of the accident in which the said Lance Edward Olaf Tunnington was killed certain moneys became payable being the proceeds of a personal accident policy taken out by the said Eagle Aviation Limited together with other moneys paid by the said Company.

9. THAT on or about the 11th day of February, 1958, I received a letter from the said Cynan Evan Davies dated the 4th February 1958 stating that he had received a cheque in respect of the moneys owing by the said Eagle Aviation Limited, after deduction of funeral expenses amounting to £68.16.0d., which had been paid by the said Eagle Aviation Limited.

10. THAT I believe that there are no amounts owing by the deceased in respect of debts funeral expenses or otherwise.
