

8. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all the remainder of my real and personal property of whatsoever nature and kind and wheresoever situate unto my trustees UPON TRUST to pay thereout my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses including all estate duty payable on both my actual and notional estate (except duty payable on my Talus Brushware shares as hereinbefore set out) and to divide the residue thereof into five equal parts to be held upon the following trusts, namely:

- (a) As to one of such parts for SELWYN HENSON the grandson of my sister, CHRISTINA MABEL GOLDSMITH absolutely if he shall survive me.
- (b) As to one of such parts for ROGER HENSON the grandson of my sister Christina Mabel Goldsmith absolutely if he shall survive me.
- (c) As to one of such parts for my nephew NOEL WEBLEY of Gisborne absolutely
- (d) As to one of such parts for my niece PHYLLIS CALDISHAW absolutely
- (e) As to the remaining one of such parts for my niece CHRISTAEEL TUNNINGTON absolutely.

AND I DIRECT that in the event of the failure of the trusts of any of the said parts the part or parts the trusts whereof so fail original as well as accruing shall be added to the others or other of the said parts the trusts whereof do not fail equally in accordance with the original division and shall be subject in all respects to the same trusts powers and provisions as herein appear concerning the part or parts to which the same shall attach.

9. I DECLARE that my trustees shall have in addition to the powers and authorities conferred upon them by law the following powers and authorities in and about the execution of the trusts of this my Will and which they may exercise in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion:

- (a) The power to invest trust moneys in the purchase of or at interest upon the security of such land, immovable property, funds, stocks, shares, securities and other investments of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situate and whether involving liability or not as my trustees shall think fit to the intent that my trustees shall have the same full and unrestricted power of investing and transposing investments in all respects as if they were absolutely entitled thereto beneficially.

- (b) The power to retain as authorised investments any property held by me at the date of my death in its then form without being responsible for loss.
- (c) The power to sell the whole or any part or parts of my estate at any time or times and at such prices and upon such terms as my trustees shall think fit.
- (d) The power to appropriate and partition any real or personal property forming part of my estate to or towards the share of any person beneficially entitled under this my Will and to charge any property so appropriated or partitioned with such sum or sums by way of equality as my trustees shall think fit and for such purpose to fix the values as my trustees shall think fit.

1. I DIRECT that my nephew FRANK WINTON PARKER shall have the right to purchase my residential property situated at Liverpool Street, Levin, at an amount equivalent to the amount accepted by the Inland Revenue Department as being the value of the said property for death duty purposes in my estate together with an amount equivalent to ten per cent (10%) of such value such option to be exercised by my said nephew within a period of six months from the date of my death and I FURTHER DIRECT that in the event of my said nephew so electing to exercise such right of purchase he shall have a further period of one month after the expiration of such period of six months within which to complete payment to my trustees.
