

THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me PETER McILVRIDE
of Dannevirke, in the Dominion of New Zealand, Retired.

HEREBY REVOKE all wills and testamentary dispositions at
whatssoever time heretofore made by me.

I APPOINT my son REGINALD HOWE-CRITCHTON McILVRIDE and my
daughter ANNIE EUPHEMIA JANET HOWATSON or the survivor of
them to be the executors and trustees of this my last will.

I FORGIVE AND RELEASE unto my said son REGINALD HOWE-CRITCHTON
McILVRIDE all sums whether for principal or interest which at
my death may be owing by him to me on the security of mortgage
registered number 72729 on his home property in High Street,
Dannevirke, and I direct that the said mortgage shall be
released and delivered by my executors to my said son at the
cost of my estate.

I GIVE DEVISE BEQUEATH AND APPOINT all the rest of my estate
both real and personal of whatsoever nature and kind and
wheresoever situate of which I shall be possessed to which
I shall be entitled or over which I shall have any disposing
power at my death unto my trustees UPON TRUST to sell call in
and convert into money all such part or parts thereof as shall
not at the time of my death consist of money with power however,
to my trustees in their absolute discretion to postpone such
sale calling in and conversion for as long as they may think
fit and out of the moneys arising from such sale calling in
and conversion together with all other moneys that may come
into the hands of my trustees as such to pay my just debts
funeral testamentary and administration expenses and all
estate and succession duties, and the residue thereof to be
divided as follows:-

(a) Two thirds to my son REGINALD HOWE-CRITCHTON McILVRIDE

(b) One third to my daughter ANNIE EUPHEMIA JANET HOWATSON

PROVIDED HOWEVER that if my said son should predecease me I
give and bequeath two-thirds of his share to his wife Ethel
McIlvride, and the remaining one third to his son Vernon
McIlvride, and PROVIDED FURTHER that if my said daughter
