You were advised recently by the Department of Labour, Immigration Division, that your temporary permit had been extended. Because of your longer stay in New Zealand, you are now required to register as an alien and I enclose a notice of your obligations.

Kindly note that exempt from registration are only diplomatic representatives and their staff and bona fide visitors staying in New Zealand for a period not exceeding three months.

According to what information I have you are not a person exempt from aliens registration, but if this is not correct I would be pleased if you would let me know why you would consider yourself exempt.

Dear Sir,

I understand that on your arrival in New Zealand on 10 August you were granted a temporary entry permit valid for two weeks due to the fact that you had lost your passport.

I am pleased to tell you that I have cancelled this permit and I wish to advise that as from the date of your arrival you are deemed to be a permanent resident of New Zealand.

The granting of this status does not affect your present nationality or citizenship, and should you wish to become a New Zealand citizen you should apply direct to the Secretary for Internal Affairs, Department of Internal Affairs, Private Bag, Wellington.

If you intend leaving New Zealand and wish to return, it will be necessary for you to obtain a re-entry permit from the nearest office of the Department of Labour. This requirement will not be necessary should you be successful in obtaining New Zealand citizenship and a New Zealand passport.
