AWARDED THE DISTINGUISHED CONDUCT MEDAL.

6/2764 Sgt. C.W. Scobie, 1st Bn. Canterbury Regt.

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty during operations on Welsh and Reb Avis Ridges from 28th September to 1st October 1918. When the enemy attacked the right flank of his company which was in the air he put up a stout resistance and, though wounded in the face and both arms continued to direct his men against the enemy, causing them to retire.

4/855 Sgt. A. Ward, 2nd Field Coy., N.Z. Engineers.

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty on the night of 4th/5th October 1918, at Rues des Vignes, in charge of a party detailed to launch a raft for the crossing of the St. Quentin Canal. He carried the material some 2000 yards through heavy shell and machine gun fire, and constructed the raft enabling the infantry to cross at dawn.

9/461 St. J. Weaver, Otago Mounted Rifles.

For gallant conduct on 8th November 1918 when, with a patrol of two men he galloped across country near Les Trois Maisons to draw hostile machine gun fire and disclose machine gun positions. On the 9th November 1918 he again did very gallant work.
