Allowed Bail.

HEMPSTEAD, Tex., Feb. 13.—District Judge Reese rendered his decision to-day in the habeas corpus case of Boulware, Wood and Wallingford, charged with murder. The two former defendants were allowed bail each in the sum of \$2500 and the latter \$1000 for appearance when the case is called during the present term of court.

The assessor of county and state taxes, R. A. Gladdish, informed the News correspondent to-day that there seems to be a general disposition among all the farmers he has visited to greatly curtail the acreage planted in cotton this season and to increase that of corn and other crops.

In the extreme southern portion of Waller county and a few other places the novel sight is seen of plowmen in one part of the field preparing the field for another cotton crop and cotton pickers at work in the other. The low prices obtained for cotton last fall and the scarcity of pickers is the cause of the notable event.
