Fields' Store had quite a reputation for fights and killings during and after the Civil War.

Some people still contend that the three children of George Lynch were killed and the home near Fields' Store set on fire while the old foks were away. All that was lift of the bodies was buried in Fields' Store Cemetery—ani rocks and bricklets still cover the grave plet.

Tempers ran high after the
Civil War and Charles Quinn
was killed during an election at
Fields' Store in November, 1892.
His uncle, Hugh Quinn, was killed in Hempstead in September,
1893, continuing the same argument.


The men are buried side by side on a plot with the father of Charles, who was a Confederate veteran

Several veterans of the Mexican and Civil Wars are buried in Fields' Store Cemetery, although quite a few of the graves are not marked.

In the 1950s the cemetery association decided to enlarge the cemetery. Now a rodeo is held every Fourth of July to raise money to take care of the grounds.

Wide spreading cedars and other trees tend to make the old cemetery a beauty spot. The Pleasant Hill Masonic Lodge has a hall just outside the cemetery fence. A church is also located just outside the gate.
