ARTICLES OF FAITH  
MASON COUNTY KENTUCKY  
JANUARY 16- 1819.

ARTICLE-1-

THE BAPTIST CHURCH of Jesus Christ on the waters of Indian Creek, called Mount Gil-ead, was constituted by Elders James Johnson and William Payne, on the day above mentioned, consists of these persons whose names are subscribed unto the following Articles hereunto annexed as the Faith and Order of said Church.

Which Articles are as follows, to wit.

Having been enabled by Divine grace to give up ourselves to the Lord and to one another by the Will of God, we do account it a duty incumbent on us to make a declaration of our Faith and Practice, which declaration is:

We believe in one only living and true God, who is Existant and Eternal, the maker and former of all things, the one Eternal Jehovah, Father, Son and Holy Ghost, in one Devine Essence and True God in One.

ARTICLE-2

We believe that the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testament are the word of God, and the only rule of Faith and Practice.

ARTICLE-3-

We believe that before the world was, God did ~~make~~ covenant with his son Jesus Christ for the redemption of his church and people, wherein he should be their Saviour, and that these persons with all their grace and glory, were put into the hands of Christ and made his care and charge.

ARTICLE-4

We believe that Jesus Christ the Son (or word) of God as the second person in the adorable Trinity was appointed the only Mediator between God and men, and that in pursuance of the gracious design He was in the fulness of time to assure human nature and in that nature he did answer all the demands of both Law and Justice in the behalf of his people, and brought in everlasting Righteousness whereby

and justify all those which believe in

Jesus.

Article -5-

We believe in God in the begining made man, upright, capable of serving and glorifying Him, but in sinning, we all sinned in Him and came short of the Glory of God, and a corrupt nature devised from him to all his posterity by Natural generations, and so all fell under the law and under its curse, from which there is no redemption but by Christ, the second Adam.

Article 6-

We believe that Regeneration and Salvation is not the act of the creature either in part or in whole, but by Jesus Christ, through the power of the Holy Ghost in the riches of His grace.

Article 7.

We believe that all those who are quickened by the Holy Ghost, and redeemed by Christ and Justified by His blood, shall finally persevere through life into eternal glory.

Article 8

We believe there be a resurrection of the just and unjust when Christ Jesus will introduce his own people into the Kingdom, there to behold forever his glory, but will banish the wicked into the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, from his presence and the glory of his power.

Article 9-

We believe that baptism and the Lord's supper are ordinances of Christ, are to be continued until his second coming, and it is to say that none are to be admitted into the Church and participate of the Lord's Supper, but those only who have been baptised on the profession of their faith, and by immersion in the name of the Holy Trinity

Now each of the foregoing articles we solemnly profess and in the presence of God, and believe it to be our duty to maintain inviolate, and as it respects the order of the Lord's house, we believe it is the duty of every member to fill his seat faithfully, whether for public worship of God, or for the business of discipline in the house of God; unless providentially prevented.

And whereas innovations are apt to creep into the Church of Christ, to the great distress and disorder of the body by entering and party spirit.

We believe it to be our duty to oppose  
unitedly everything that shall intrude  
on the feelings or fellowship of our Brethren,  
whether it be in doctrine, the administration  
of Ordinances or discipline, that those only are  
to officiate in the celebration of the  
ordinances, who have been regularly ordained and  
Unanimously Called by the Church for that  
purpose, and furthermore we believe it to be our duty,  
duty to walk in love and lowliness of mind,  
esteeming each other better than our selves.  
Abstaining and reproofing one another in case of  
visible fault and also to receive reproof from our  
brethren, and not to divulge the faults of our brother  
brethren, but to be governed in all cases by  
the rule laid down by our Lord in the 14th of  
Mathew, and for the General peace and unity  
of the body, all questions shall be decided  
by the general suffrage of the body then present.  
We also believe it to be our duty to contribute for the  
support of the Gospel and therefore to bear our  
portion of the expenses that may arise in  
decocntly maintaining the worship of God in  
His house.

And lastly so to conduct ourselves as to  
not give any just cause of offence to them  
that are without, nor to the Church of God  
which we both adore and admire the grace of  
God that has given us a name and place that  
is better than sons and daughters.

Said Shotwells sell to said Trustees for the sum of three lbs, three shillings, and six pence, one and one quarter acres of ground on the Great Road from Limestone to Lexington, and a part of the plantation whereon said Shotwell now lives and on which a Meeting House now stands -on the road two poles from ssid Shotwell line, south along the Great Road, etc. for only proper use of a Meeting House and a burying ground.
