Ex-Confederate Meeting Waller County Effects Organization and Appoints Delegates to a State Convention

EX-CONFEDERATE MEETING.

Waller County Effects Organization and Appoints Delegates to a State Convention.

HEMPSTEAD, Tex., August 12.—The ex-confederates of Waller county met at the court-house at 3 p. m. Saturday. The meeting was called to order by T. Johnson, who placed in nomination T. S. Reese to act as chairman. Mr. Reese was unanimously elected chairman and J. M. Pinckney secretary. The president stated the object of the meeting, which was for the purpose of forming an ex-confederate association in Waller county, the same to work for the benefit of the confederate home and for the purpose of sending delegates to a state convention soon to be called for the purpose of organizing an ex-confederate state association.

After speeches by Messrs. Johnson, Harvey and Morrison as to the best plan of organizing, a motion prevailed that the chairman appoint a committee of five to select delegates to the state convention when called.

The chair appointed R. N. Faulkner, A. J. Harvey, T. Johnson, R. N. Pinckney and G. W. Ellington. They reported T. S. Reese, R. N. Faulkner, A. J. Harvey, John M. Pinckney and T. Johnson as selected. The delegates were unanimously agreed to with power to appoint their own substitutes.

It was moved that the secretary correspond with the different counties in regard to this movement, and that he furnish THE GALVESTON NEWS, Houston Post and Waller County Courier with the proceedings of this meetings, and request that they be made public.

A motion that all ex-confederates present who wish to join this association, now enroll his name with the secretary, prevailed, and the following names were enrolled: R. H. Faulkner, J. H.
